Fatima Centenary: This is the Centenary year of the Fatima apparitions, and the World Apostolate of Fatima (WAF) England and Wales National Pilgrim Virgin statue, and relics of Blessed Jacinta and Francisco Marto, will be visiting Cathedrals and churches, including St Joseph's Cathedral in Swansea from 27-28 May 2017.

Sat 27th May at the National Shrine of Our Lady of the Taper at Cardigan - The programme starts at 10 am to include Rosary and mass and presentations, confession etc

Sunday 28th St Josephs Cathedral -The Cathedral Hall will be open from 2.30pm for prayer and private devotion prior to the procession. At 15:00 , the Bishop will preside over a Marian celebration which will include a procession and rosary and crowning. This will conclude with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament and veneration of the relics of the new saints. The statue will arrive in time for the 5.30pm Vigil Mass followed by devotions There will also be devotions after the usual 8am and 10.30 am Sunday Masses.

Kwalukonge Clinic, Tanzania: Fr. Ambrose Chuwa, the clinic director, was in touch last week to thank us for our latest donation of 206,328.31 Tanzanian shillings (£77) raised in our monthly tea and coffee gatherings. The support is greatly appreciated. He also asks our prayers - the region has been hit by floods. At least ten people have died and houses and cars were carried towards mountains where they were smashed on huge boulders.The clinic continues to provide a service, but staff are 'locked in' - the roads are impassable meaning that the ambulance cannot pick up either patients or medicines. And, of course, crops will have been affected.

Vocations Prayer


