N.B. RETURNING TO MASS – PENTECOST SUNDAY (EXTRACT) “ The pressing challenges of the pandemic have lessened significantly. Most people have resumed the wide range of normal activities, no longer restricted by the previous Covid measures. We therefore believe that the reasons which have prevented Catholics from attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation no longer apply” – “ when the freedom of any Catholic to attend Mass in person is impeded for a serious reason, because of situations such as ill health, care for the sick or legitimate fear, this is not a breach of the Sunday Obligation” – “ Looking forward to the forthcoming feast of Pentecost, we now invite all Catholics who have not yet done so to return to attending Mass in person”.

The Synodal Process – Passing Christ’s Love On The Diocese of Menevia have published the replies from the parishes to the Synod questions. (The full response is available on the Parish Website). The Diocesan response to the Synod recommends that parishes reach out more to their communities. At our meeting on Monday 18th July, we discussed how St. Joseph’s could respond. One idea was a drop-in coffee morning as an opportunity to meet more people - on **Thursdays in the Parish Hall from 10-00a.m. to 11-00 a.m.** .It is a social occasion where everyone is welcome to come along, parishioners and non-parishioners alike. We encourage you to come along and please mention it to, and bring along, any friends and neighbours who would enjoy themselves there. Another idea was to encourage parishioners who have not yet returned to Mass following Covid, or those who have lapsed, by taking an extra copy of the Parish Newsletter and delivering to them so that they know what is happening at St. Joseph’s.
