The Year of St.Joseph A daily prayer to St.Joseph.... and a challenge. Pope Francis tells us that, "Every day, for over forty years, following Morning Prayer" he has recited a prayer to St.Joseph taken from a French prayerbook of the Congregation of the Sisters of Jesus and Mary. This prayer, he says, expresses devotion and trust, and even "a certain challenge to St.Joseph" on account of its closing words: "My beloved father, my trust is in you. Let it not be said that I invoked you in vain, and since you can do everything with Jesus and Mary, show me that your goodness is as great as your power". At the conclusion to his Letter, he adds another prayer to St.Joseph. "Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. To you God entrusted His only Son; in you Mary placed her trust; with you Christ became a man. Blessed St.Joseph, to us too, show yourself to be a father, and guide us in the path of life. Obtain for us grace, mercy and courage, and defend us from every evil. Amen"
