We have been asked by the Diocese to, once again, make very clear the absolute importance of continuing to strictly observe all the necessary precautions. These precautions continue to apply even if you have received the Coronavirus Vaccine. Please wear a mask at all times, sanitise your hands before entering the church and on leaving the church. Please continue to observe social distancing, especially when invited to come forward to receive Holy Communion. Please do not walk about the church or against the direction of the arrows and please do not bunch up with others on entering and leaving the church or gather in a group outside of church but continue to keep six feet apart at all times.

<u>LENT 2021</u> (Please pick up the Lent 2021 sheet as you leave). This Wednesday (**Ash Wednesday**) marks the beginning of Lent. We pray that in these difficult times, through which we are passing, the Lord will bring us through (as through a period of purification) to Resurrection and a New Pentecost, and that our Lenten abstinences and prayers will deepen our sense that "we hang like a drop of dew upon a blade of grass" (W.B.Yeats). Conscious of the frailty and fragility of life, may we be given the grace to cast ourselves with greater abandonment upon the empowering mercy of God's love for us, revealed to us in the Death of Christ and His glorious Resurrection on Easter Morning.

CAFOD Big Walk for Water. This Lent CAFOD invites those who are able to join this virtual event on Saturday 20th February at 2-00p.m. (within current guidelines) to walk a route of up to five miles in solidarity with so many around the world whose daily lives revolve around collecting water. People like Abdella, 23,who spends 10 hours every day in temperatures above 40c in an extremely remote and mountainous part of Ethiopia. Abdella feels very frustrated as it leaves him no time for anything else. Could you Walk for Water as a personal Lenten challenge by walking 5 miles/10,000 steps every day for 40 days?
