The Year of St.Joseph A daily prayer to St.Joseph. "Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Ascension Day and Pentecost Forty days after His Resurrection Jesus ascended into heaven having commanded the disciples to wait in Jerusalem and to pray for Coming of the Holy Spirit. Ten days later, the Risen, Ascended and Glorified Jesus, seated at the right hand of the Father, sent down upon the Church the Gift of the Holy Spirit on the Day of Pentecost. Throughout the coming years, as recorded in the Acts of the Apostles, the Holy Spirit continued to be poured out upon the Church and also throughout the two thousand year history of the Church in times of renewal and refreshment in the life of the Church. We continue to pray that, in our day, the Risen Jesus may once again awaken us, as a Church, and pour out the Holy Spirit upon us. This Thursday is Ascension Day and allows us to begin a novena (nine days) of prayer for the coming down of the Holy Spirit.

Holy Spirit, Lord of Light, from the clear celestial height, Thy pure beaming radiance give. Come, Thou Father of the poor, come with treasures that endure, Come Thou Light of all that live. Light Immortal, Light Divine, Visit Thou this soul of mine, Wash the stain of guilt away. Bend the stubborn heart and will, Melt the frozen, warm the chill, Guide the steps that go astray. Come, Holy Spirit!
