Dr Barbara Green (RIP) Dr Barbara Green, whose first anniversary we remember in Mass next Sunday was, over several years (from 2013) a very generous (but anonymous) benefactor to St.Joseph's Church. It is appropriate on her anniversary to now acknowledge her great generosity to the parish which for six years, from 2013 to 2019, amounted to the sum of £35,250 and enabled us not only to become solvent as a parish – (when I arrived in 2015 we were £12,000 in debt) but also contributed (along with others) to the cost of removing dangerous asbestos from the boiler room, to install a new boiler and to renovate and restore the sanctuary. It is with a great sense of thanksgiving that I am now able to announce that in her Will Barbara bequeathed to St.Joseph's the further sum of £40,000. We thank God for Barbara's generosity and intend to direct her bequest to the Driveway Appeal Fund and thank God for this answer to prayer. We hoped to raise approximately £60,000 and, with Barbara's bequest we now have £46,650 in the Fund with "only" (!) a further £13,350 to raise. We hope to employ the services of a surveyor in the next few months to design and cost tarmacking (and draining) the driveway/carpark and installing some form of lighting for the driveway/carpark.
