## **SECOND LOCKDOWN!**

(Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> October – Monday 9<sup>th</sup> November)

As announced by the First Minister of Wales, Mark Drayford, all places of worship in Wales have been asked to close from 23rd October until 9<sup>th</sup> November, but allowing funerals and weddings to take place under the usual pandemic restrictions. This is very disappointing for those places of worship (like ourselves) which have been observing the necessary precautions (sanitising gel, masks, social distancing etc) to enable public worship to continue. The precedent of the State requiring the suspension of public worship (the freedom of religion) is an unhappy precedent — (and one hopes that the leaders of the churches in Wales have made appropriate representations to the Welsh Government) — which the Church is able to comply with because of the prevailing circumstances, but which does not token well for a proper understanding between the Church and the State, for which the Church has had to suffer in previous generations and for which we also, in future years, may be required to take a stand. It is unfortunate that there seems to have been no discussion about these important issues whilst, on this occasion, seeking to accommodate the requirements (demands) of the civic authorities. What are the limits to the authority of the State? Are there limits?

Our public celebration of Mass will begin on <u>Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> November</u> with Mass at 9-30 a.m. (St.Joseph's) and 11-00a.m. (St.John Kemble). Please continue to pray that through these ups and downs of public life, the Lord will work in us His deeper and more perfect Will for the Church and that through this disruption of our community (and liturgical) life as the Body of Christ, He will bring us through to Resurrection and a New Pentecost. Come, Holy Spirit! Come, Lord Jesus!

# Novena to the Holy Spirit

### Prayer of Pope Saint John XX111 -An Invocation of the Holy Spirit.

"Renew Your wonders in this our day, as by a New Pentecost. Grant to Your Church that, being of one mind and steadfast in prayer with Mary, the Mother of Jesus, and following the lead of blessed Peter, she may advance the reign of our Divine Saviour, the reign of truth and justice, the reign of love and peace. Come Holy Spirit, in Your power and might to renew the face of the earth. Amen".

First Day: "Holy Spirit, Lord of Light, From the clear celestial height, Thy pure beaming radiance give".

O God, You taught the hearts of Your faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit. Grant that by the gift of the same Spirit I may be always truly wise and ever rejoice in His consolations. Amen.

Second Day: "Come Thou Father of the poor, Come with treasures that endure, Come Thou Light of all that live".

O Holy Spirit, Father of the poor, come fill my poverty-stricken soul out of the plenty of Your eternal riches. Warn me, I beg You, of every opportunity in my daily round of duty to lay up treasures where no thief approaches nor moth corrupts, that I may enjoy them together with You forever. Amen.

Third Day: "Thou of all consolers best, Thou, the soul's delightsome Guest, Thy refreshing peace bestow".

O Divine Consoler, and of all comforters the best, to You do I come in trouble and distress. May You, in the all-powerful Name of Jesus our Redeemer, and out of love for Mary, our sorrowful Mother and Your chaste spouse, come to my assistance and comfort me in all my trials and tribulations. Amen.

Fourth Day: "Thou in toil art comfort sweet, Pleasant coolness in the heat, Solace in the midst of woe".

O God, You bestowed the Holy Spirit on the Apostles. Grant to Your people the effect of their pious prayers, that on those to whom You have given grace, You may bestow peace. Amen.

Fifth Day: "Light Immortal, Light Divine, Visit Thou these hearts of Thine, And our inmost being fill".

May the Paraclete, Who proceeds from You, enlighten my mind, I beseech You, O Lord; and even as Your Son has promised, may He lead me into all truth. Amen.

Sixth Day: "If Thou take Thy grace away, Nothing pure in us will stay, All our good is turned to ill".
